## Verallia awards its 1<sup>st</sup> Sustainable Supplier Award to Cartonplast Ibérica

The jury, comprising the Group Purchasing Director, Director of Operations, CSR Director and General Counsel, Sustainability Director and Compliance Officer, awarded Cartonplast Ibérica this first 2023 Award.
